BDPEMS – Berlin Doctoral Program in Economics and Management Science

Building on Berlin's unique and manifold academic environment, the Berlin Doctoral Program in Economics and Management Science (BDPEMS) provides outstanding doctoral students with state-of-the-art training in economics, finance, econometrics, and management science. It brings together expertise and excellence from all major universities and research institutions in Berlin. The program's vision is to become one of Europe's leading programs for top-level graduate education in economics and management.

BDPEMS closely collaborates with the *Research Training Group (RTG) 1659 "Interdependencies in the regulation of markets"*, which builds on BDPEMS first-year training, and the *International Research Training Group (IRTG) 1792 "High Dimensional Non Stationary Time Series"*.

The program further cooperates with the Graduate Center of the German Institute for Economic Research (DIW) and all major research centers and initiatives in Berlin.

Embedded in this broad and inspiring academic network, students select from a wide variety of courses and activities. Since 2011 the program is funded by the Einstein foundation Berlin.

The program follows leading international standards with an emphasis on rigorous analytical methods and quantitative analysis preparing students for cutting-edge research in a broad range of fields. It provides core education in macroeconomics, microeconomics, management science, and econometrics.

- bachelors degree or higher, preferably in economics, business administration, mathematics, statistics, physics, or engineering
- GRE General Test
- TOEFL or IELTS (except if your native language is English or if you earned a previous university degree from an English speaking program)

ADMISSION

- once each year starting in October
- deadline for applications: March 31st
